Installer will prepare installation area by removing four (4) inches of slab and/or foundation. Installer will excavate sub-grade material. Due to variations in concrete FlatSafe is not responsible for concrete chipping or cracking which may occur while cutting. Homeowner is responsible for any sub-grade obstruction such as plumbing, utility lines, cables, water or any other obstruction. If rock is found and larger rental equipment is required homeowner is responsible for any and all equipment rental charges. FlatSafe will not add any additional labor charges for first day. If additional days are required FlatSafe will charge \$600.00 for each additional day. FlatSafe is not responsible if post tension cables are cut. It is the homeowner's responsibility to check prior to install for post tension cables.

Homeowner must cancel installation 48 hours prior to install. If homeowner does not cancel 48 hours prior to installation, FlatSafe Tornado Shelters will retain any and all down payment.

Any and all alterations or modifications by homeowner or installer, and cost associated with them, must be agreed upon between the parties in writing prior to work being performed. Payment for any and all alterations or modifications must be paid for at completion of installation.

FlatSafe Tornado Shelter representative shall provide required specifications and structural analysis for securing necessary permits. Unless noted by FlatSafe representative homeowner is responsible for obtaining required permits.

This agreement shall be interpreted and enforced under Oklahoma law without reference to principles of conflicts of laws. Jurisdiction and venue for any dispute shall lie in the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma. If FlatSafe prevails in legal dispute they are entitled to attorney fees.

FlatSafe will charge a monthly late fee of 1.5% on any and all unpaid balance due. Credit card merchant surcharges may apply.

The FlatSafe warranty covers structural failure of Galvanized and HDPE Components on a FlatSafe Tornado Shelter used in domestic dwellings in the United States due to corrosion within 50 years from the date of installation. Date and Installation location (host dwelling) provided by customer upon registration. FlatSafe shelters with an Epoxy or painted coating are warranted for 5 years from the date of installation.
